Call to Artists for December's Gift Shop in the Gallery!

The gallery committee is proposing the brilliant idea of turning the entire gallery into a gift shop for the month of December. Let's make our Blaine Art Gallery THE destination for everyone's gift-giving this year!

Here's how it works:

The walls will be divided into thirds (the size of the recessed walls on the back wall), and we invite you to submit art no larger than 15" square to show in the divided sections.

Options for showing will be: a Christmas tree in the window for ornaments, cards in the window and racks, print stands, the three wood shelves connecting the gallery and gift shop, and four, 4' pedestals for display purposes.

Please be sure you have enough inventory to show as your work sells during the month. The idea is to offer art that is small enough for people to give as gifts as well as showcasing our artists' many talents. We're looking to have 14 to 18 artists participate which means your work commitment in the gallery will only be 1 to 2 days over the course of the entire month.

The fee will be \$145.00 for the month, with no commission. The show will be well promoted and advertised.
